Commonwealth in Phase Green

COVID-19 UPDATE

Shift to Phase Green: On June 26th, the Commonwealth of PA shifted Montgomery County to Phase Green. LUMC will remain in its current status of closed to all activity until further notice, except for the LiveStream service on Sunday mornings and other approved exceptions made by the Pastor or the Trustees. Once in Phase Green, faithful, prudent, and safe decisions will be announced when applicable. There is no definite timetable for reopening the church in the early portion of Phase Green. In the meantime, please commit yourselves to prayers for all those who have suffered personal and economic losses during the pandemic crisis.

The Church Council reviewed the results on Monday evening and drew the conclusion that a majority of those surveyed prefer to wait to either return to worship sometime in the autumn or to wait for a vaccine to be available. Since it's important to honor the thoughts and feelings of our worshipers, the council has elected

to take a slow and steady course to return to in-person worship when it's faithful, prudent, and safe to do so. As plans formulate, you can expect to be kept informed. In the survey, about 12 people indicated they'd return immediately to worship if it was possible. Pastor Bill would like to hear from those people to talk about some options. E-mail and voicemail will not be checked on those days.

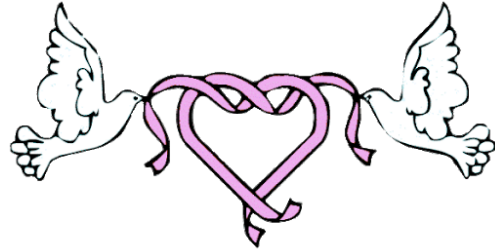
Lansdale UMC Has a New Website!

Dismantling Racism: Pressing on to Freedom - August Town Hall



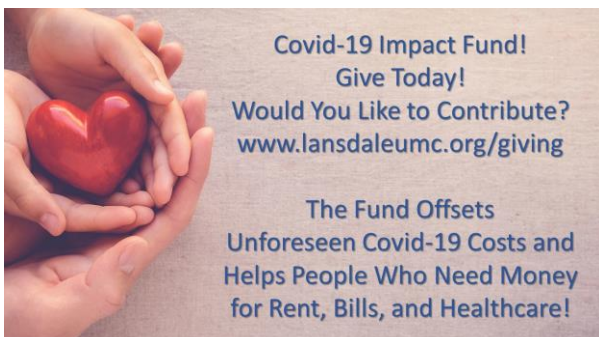
On August 26, UMC.org will host a Town Hall conversation that will help us see today's work of dismantling racism in light of what has gone before.

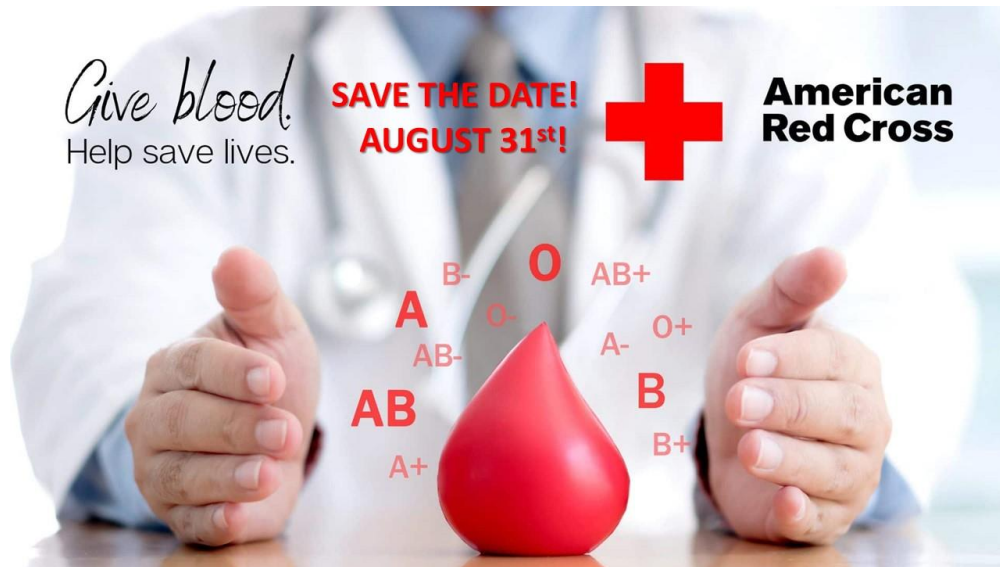

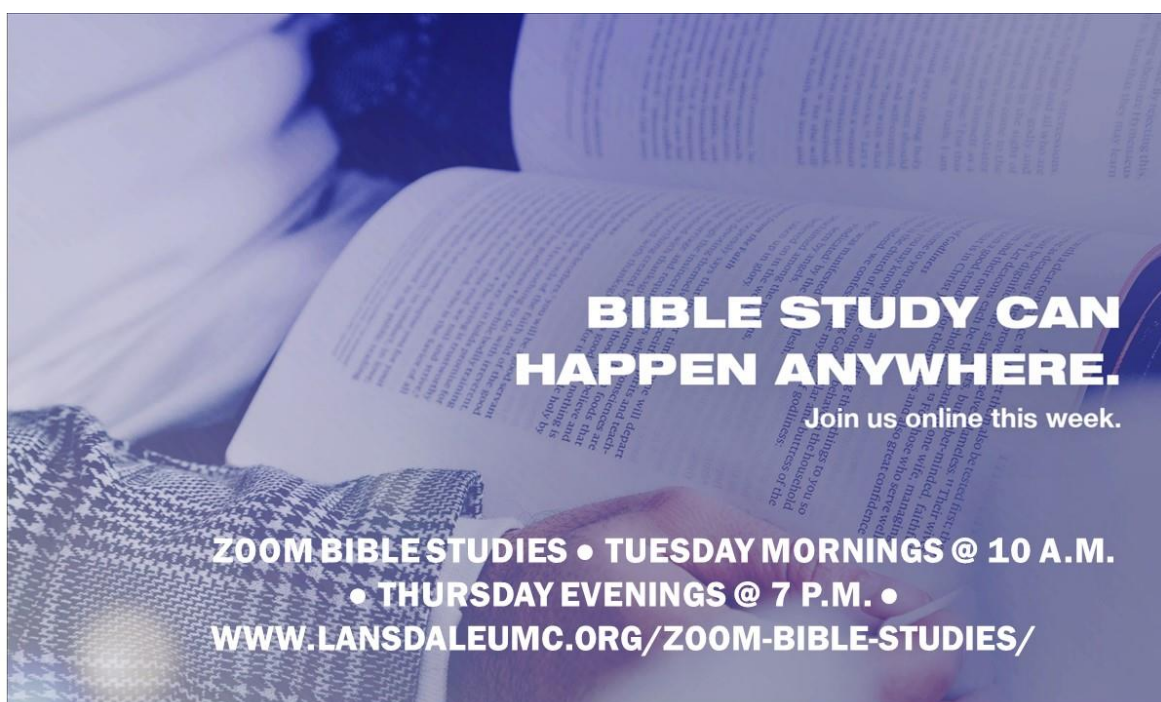
