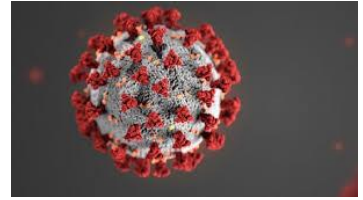

UPDATED! – COVID-19 STATUS – NEW! **Commonwealth Continues an Outbreak**



On **Thursday, January 7th**, the Commonwealth of PA recorded 9,698 new coronavirus cases, a 50% increase in 48 hours. The positivity rate in the Commonwealth averages at 15%, which signals the virus is not under control. Montgomery County's positivity rate is near 14%, which means an outbreak is still in progress. LUMC will remain in its current limited opening status until further notice, except for the LiveStream service on Sunday mornings and other approved exceptions made by the Pastor or the Trustees. Faithful, prudent, and safe decisions will be announced when applicable. In the meantime, please commit yourselves to prayers for all those who have suffered personal and economic losses during the pandemic emergency.
