



UPDATED! - COVID-19 STATUS - NEW! Cases Beginning to Plateau!

On **Tuesday, March 9th**, Montco's rate of new coronavirus cases inched up to 114 per 100,000 residents, a modest decline of 2% over the last 14



days. A plateau may be developing. Hospitalizations remain down, and the number of deaths (55 in 14 days) remains a source of sadness. The test positivity rate has declined to 5%, the recommended minimum rate, giving hope that the virus is tamping down. The county is still listed at "very high risk" based on per capita cases and test positivity, according to Commonwealth and Montco health authorities. The White House Coronavirus Task Force lists Montco in "phase yellow." Therefore, caution is still the best course to follow for now. We're inching closer to a limited return to in-person worship. Until then, LUMC will remain in its current status of restricted opening for LiveStream worship and other approved uses. The numbers must continue moving in the right direction! Vaccinations are essential to help that happen! Be in prayer as we close in on a full year of the pandemic emergency.



Zoom Bible Studies in Lent Continue! You can join your congregation, friends, and Pastor Bill at two Zoom Bible Studies each week during Lent. The **Tuesday mornings** at 10:00 a.m. gathering will remain as a study of the appointed lectionary readings for each of the Tuesdays in Lent. On

Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. during Lent, Pastor Bill will lead a **Lenten Bible Study** called *Behold the Lamb, Behold the Man*, a biblical and theological examination of the *Lamb of God* title for Jesus used in the New testament. 
