



UPDATED! - COVID-19 STATUS - NEW!

Currently, Montco's case count is escalating, which is not the best news. The British variant of Covid-19 is in the county. At current case levels, the county remains in the **very high risk** category according to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, the



Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and Montgomery County health authorities. The test positivity rate has risen to **8%**, which suggests that the virus isn't under control and that cases are undercounted. Vaccinations are proceeding, which is great news. Vaccinations will get us back to in-person worship in the quickest way. Please consider prayerfully receiving one of the very safe and effective vaccines. For the time being, caution is the wisest course of action. LUMC will remain in its current status of limited openings for LiveStream worship and other approved uses. Let your prayers flow for the many who are suffering and have died, and for the many who grieve and mourn.

Bishop Johnson's Gift of Easter Worship at 9:00 a.m.

Today's service is a gift from Bishop Peggy Johnson, who serves the Philadelphia Episcopal Area of The United Methodist Church. Bishop Johnson and a team of worship leaders prepared a worship service and sermon for use during the Easter Season. The aim behind the gift was to offer pastor's a Sunday of rest.

Bishop Johnson is a native of Baltimore, Maryland, serves the Eastern Pennsylvania Annual Conference and the Peninsula-Delaware Annual Conference. She received a Bachelor of Science degree from Lebanon Valley College, a Master of Divinity from Asbury Theological Seminary and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Wesley Theological Seminary. Prior to her election to the episcopacy in 2008, she served as a pastor in the Baltimore-Washington Conference since 1980. Her churches included a 4-point rural circuit in Frederick, MD, a suburban Baltimore congregation, a campus ministry at Gallaudet University, and for 20 years she was the pastor of the Christ UMC of the Deaf. Bishop Johnson has a particular passion for ministry with people with disabilities. During her tenure as a bishop she has served as a board member on the Commission on the Status and Role of Women and on the General Board of Church and Society. She authored a UMW "Mission U" study book: "The Church and Disabilities" in 2014. She is married to the Rev. Michael C. Johnson, a United Methodist pastor, and they have two adult sons, Peter and Gabriel.
