Leone E. Slyh of Lansdale was 92 when she died on Thursday, May 27, 2021 at Elm Terrace Gardens, also in Lansdale. She was the wife of the late John A. “Jack” Slyh. Leone was born on June 16, 1928 in Pipestone, MN. She was the daughter of the late Herman and Emma Mettenbrink Hubner.

Leone graduated from Rochester Jr. College in Rochester, MN, in 1948 with an A.A. in Medical Secretarial Science. Her adventurous spirit took her to Denver, Co, where she began work as a medical secretary at Denver General Hospital on July 1, 1948. It is here she met the love of her life, Jack Slyh. While she didn’t have plans to get married, in time Jack changed that and they wed on August 7, 1951. She relocated to Columbus, OH, and then later moved with Jack and their two girls to Lansdale, PA in 1955, where she lived her remaining years.

An avid scholar, Leone took classes at the University of Colorado, University of Minnesota, and Ohio State University, pursuing her interests of Medical Records, Technology, Sociology, and Psychology. She had dreams of becoming a social worker and was on track to graduate in 1952 until marriage changed her plans! She then devoted her life to being a wife, mother, and grandmother.

Leone kept busy with a variety of organizations, many of which she held leadership positions. She was a member of Lansdale United Methodist Church, Lansdale Women’s Club, who made her an honorary lifetime member, Priscilla Chapter No. 64 of the Eastern Star, National Association of Parliamentarians and was a registered Parliamentarian, Women of the YWCA, North Penn Hospital Auxiliary, AARP, American Association of University Women, Epsilon Sigma Alpha (Alpha ETA Chapter in Denver, CO and was a longtime member of Indian Valley Country Club. Leone was an avid bridge player and was a friend to everyone with her gift of gab and beautiful smile!
