Congregational Care Team Update

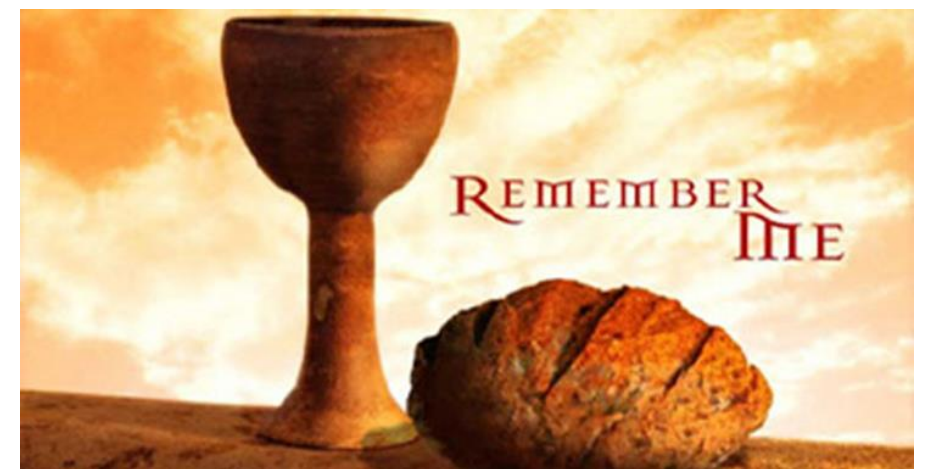

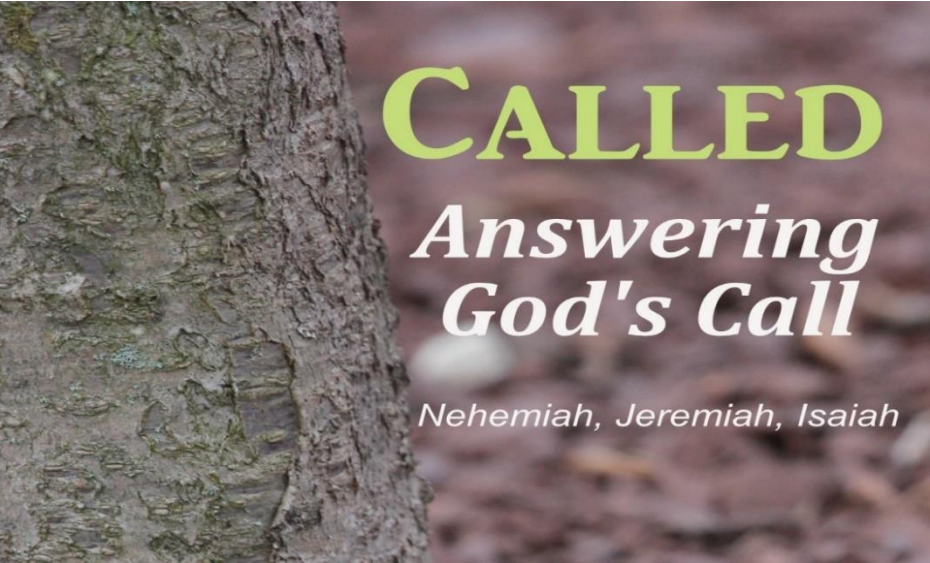
