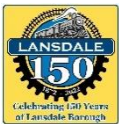
Summer Camps for Children & Youth

Help Build Hope Build-April 22-24

Last year Bethel Hill UMC performed a build for Help Build Hope. The project involved constructed all the exterior and interior wall framing and wall sheathing for a two-story house. After all the panels were built the first floor was assembled and people were invited to write messages, etc. on the walls. The panels were then shipped to the Allentown area where Habitat For Humanity constructed the house. We had a number of LUMC members and friends participate last year spring. Quite a few people also participated in another build at Lima UMC past fall. When I first heard about this event it did not seem like it could work. After working at two builds, I can see that the Lord must be present, because it works extremely well. Most of the participants are not skilled in construction (many apparently have never used a hammer). Children are also able to attend and help (and they do!). The work gets done fast because of the number of people involved and the excellent organization provided by Help Build Hope. On Friday the wood is cut to size and organized. Saturday, when all the construction takes place, is the day help is needed the most. Sunday is a dedication service. Help is also needed to take the "house" apart and load it on a truck. I hope you consider attending this build. It is a very worthwhile experience. Maryellen, my daughter Aubrey, her husband Andrew, and my Grand children have participated and enjoyed it!
