On Friday the wood is cut to size and organized. Saturday, when all the construction takes place, is the day help is needed the most. Sunday is a dedication service. Help is also needed to take the "house" apart and load it on a truck. I hope you consider attending this build. It is a very worthwhile experience. Summer Camps for Children & Youth


