
Summer Camps for Children & Youth

All members of Lansdale UMC who are attending college for the 2022-2023 school year are eligible to apply for the following Scholarships:

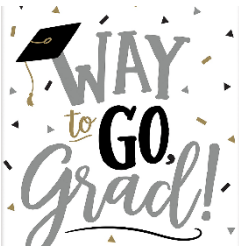
