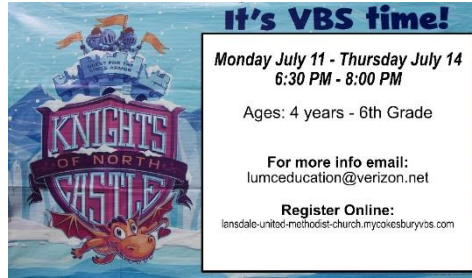

Afghanistan slipped like sand through my fingers. I scrambled to reach U.S. and U.N. contacts and devise a plan to get me and my family out of

the country but unfortunately, I could not help my family to skip from Afghanistan, and I came alone here with my husband. It wasn't just about

the loss of my work, my possessions, my home. my life was in danger “It has all been life-Changing for me” Fortunately I am here in USA; hope I

could help my family to came to USA one day. At the end let me Thank you all for the wonderful gifts.
