April Mission Emphasis

The Blue Envelope for April will support United Methodist Camps. LUMC has had relationships with Camp Innabah and Pocono Plateau, and we will designate the money for those two camps. Innabah's mission is to provide experiences that last a lifetime in an environment where campers and guests can

make new friends, challenge themselves, and explore and grow in their faith. In similar fashion, Pocono Plateau Camp and Retreat is a year-round Christian camp and retreat center located on 750 acres with two lakes in the beautiful Pocono Mountains of northeastern Pennsylvania. Facilities are available to book for retreats and day events by groups, organizations and schools from mid-August through May. They have an Adventure Program that offers fun, physical challenges for groups.

LUMC partnership with Heeding God's Call to End Gun Violence

Heeding God's Call to End Gun Violence is the faith-based and grassroots organization headquartered in Philadelphia that partnered with our church for the Memorial to the Lost t-shirt display that was on our lawn in January. Since then, Pastor Stew, members of LUMC and other Lansdale area faith communities have been working on organizing a Lansdale Gun Violence Awareness (GVA) Day. This event is scheduled for Sunday, May 21st at 3:30 pm. This event is intended to educate and energize faith institutions and their members to act to change the culture and laws about guns. The focus of the GVA Day will be working together to dismantle the illegal handgun distribution system that floods streets and neighborhoods. The GVA Day will begin at a local faith institution (yet-to-be-determined) for brief interfaith worship. There will then be a witness walk through the streets to a second faith institution (yet-to-be-determined) for an outdoor Remembrance Service and Call to Action at the Memorial to the Lost t-shirt display. Following the Remembrance Service, there will be an opportunity to engage in advocacy by signing letters to state and federal legislators calling for common sense gun laws. 
