


Every summer, campers come to Pocono Plateau to be in community with others their age, immersed in nature and challenged to grow in their faith and personal development. They come from different backgrounds, different locations, and might not have ever connected in other settings.

Would you consider helping to provide this space for today's children and teens? We have a few camps this summer with needs for counselors:

Sunday July 9th - Friday July 14th:

- 1 male counselor for a 3rd - 6th grade Camp Mania (main site)
- 1 male counselor for Into the Wild (hill) 4th - 7th grade
- Someone who can lead music/play guitar for youth camp (main site) (6th - 12th grade)

Sunday July 16th - Friday July 21st:

- 2 counselors for a Jr High Main Site
- 1 counselor for 3rd - 6th Adventure Quest (main site)
- 1 male counselor for Jr High After Dark (hill - not an all night camp!)

Sunday July 23rd - Friday July 28th:

- 1 counselor for Pioneer Outpost (JR High) (male preferred)

We allow counselors to be ages 17 and up, and counselors need to be at least 2 years older than the camp's oldest camper. Counselors receive a discount for their children to attend camp (email camp@poconoplateau.org for details). Volunteers can arrive the Saturday before their camp starts, or Sunday morning of the camp week. Camp ends on Friday evenings.
