August Congregation Meeting

Church Council will hold a congregational meeting on Sunday, August 13 at 10:15 AM immediately following worship to consider a redistribution of funds to help us meet ministry expenses. Council will propose a plan to move funds from three different areas to meet ministry expenses.

\$15,057 from balance remaining in the Covid-19 Impact Fund \$4,000 from the Library fund \$1,700 from the Living Water Service fund

\$20,757 Total (estimated amount)

Monthly expenses tend to be around \$26,000 each month. Total monthly income is around \$18-19,000 per month. We typically make up income shortfalls around Easter and in December of each year around Christmas.

Church Council wants to move the above funds into the budget to meet ministry expenses. The August meeting is an attempt to be transparent and to test the will of the congregation around taking these steps. Please plan to attend the August 13 meeting. Any other second mile giving over and above your regular giving will also be greatly appreciated. Thank you for your faithfulness in giving.

Help Needed for Inter-Faith Housing Alliance in September

Lansdale UMC will be working with Inter-Faith Housing Alliance, or as we know it, Family Promise, to house (up to) three homeless families in our building during the month of September (8/29 – 9/30). This is a wonderful opportunity for outreach for our congregation.

Since we last hosted in November the food program has been changed to only include meals for the families on Monday, Wednesdays and Fridays. The families will be able to use other resources for the remaining days' food needs. We will gladly accept gift cards for meals and/or gas for the families as a way to participate in this mission as well.

Drivers *may* be needed to transport the families to and from the day facility in Ambler. At this time, the families all have their own transportation but this may change at any time during the month. We will need to have volunteers ready if the need for drivers becomes necessary.
