August Congregation Meeting

Church Council will hold a congregational meeting TODAY, August 13 at 10:15 AM immediately following worship to consider a redistribution of funds to help us meet ministry expenses. Council will propose a plan to move funds from three different areas to meet ministry expenses.

\$15,057 from balance remaining in the Covid-19 Impact Fund \$4,000 from the Library fund \$1,700 from the Living Water Service fund

\$20,757 Total (estimated amount)

Monthly expenses tend to be around \$26,000 each month. Total monthly income is around \$18-19,000 per month. We typically make up income shortfalls around Easter and in December of each year around Christmas.

Church Council wants to move the above funds into the budget to meet ministry expenses. The meeting is an attempt to be transparent and to test the will of the congregation around taking these steps.
