

World Communion

On Sunday, October 1^{st,} we celebrate World Communion. We recognize that Holy Communion joins us in



Christian unity. This sacrament invites us to focus on the holiness of communion with God and one another. On World Communion Sunday - United Methodists, in conjunction with other denominations and believers worldwide, participate in communion to recognize our unity in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

We also receive a special offering on World Communion Sunday. Your donations support racial and ethnic students in achieving their educational goals and transforming communities. In 2021, World Communion Sunday offerings awarded 242 scholarships and grants. Your generosity continues to provide scholarships, grants, mentoring and training for leadership development. The needs exceed what we can fund, and your gifts can further growth and success.

Fifty percent of the offering provides scholarships for graduate students from the U.S. and other countries. Thirty-five percent supports racial and ethnic scholarships for students pursuing ordained ministry (deacon or elder) and includes a mentoring program. Fifteen percent funds Ethnic-In-Service Training Grant for leadership development, recruitment, training, and retention of ethnic United Methodist persons in leadership positions in every level of the church and its ministry.

Acts Bible Study Group

We have nine people signed up for the Acts Bible study group so far. More are welcome to join the group. The study group will meet weekly on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm - 8:30 pm beginning October 4. Pastor Warner will preach on a section of Acts on Sunday and the study group will study the same section that week following the sermon. The group session will also be broadcast on Zoom for people who may not be able to be physically present. You can purchase the book "Life Lessons from Acts: Christ's Church in the World" by Max Lucado from Amazon.com or from other major bookstores or websites. Purchase the study guide prior to attending the class. The group will meet for 12 weeks. We are currently scheduled to meet in the Conference Room next to the church office. We may change locations if the group gets too large. Please let Pastor Warner know if you will be participating in the group.

Note from the Pastor

Roots grown deep provide nurture and help plants persevere during harsh weather. They bring nourishment to plants. They provide sturdiness during difficult times. Plants can wither and die during difficult weather when

there is an inadequate root system. Roots is part of why I've chosen to preach a sermon series on the book of Acts for twelve weeks. Acts describes the birth and growth of the early Christian Church. It is an exciting book. There are both successes and failures as the church grew and expanded. There were challenges and disagreements. These followers of Jesus turned the world upside down as they followed Jesus' example of love of God and neighbor. While there were leaders, there were no kings or presidents. Leadership acted as servants and examples.

Two things will occur during the next three months. I'll be preaching a sermon series on the book of Acts. The series will be based on Max Lucado's book *Life Lessons from Acts*. We will also use this book as the basis for a Bible Study small group that will meet each Wednesday from 7-8:30 pm beginning Oct 4. The Bible Study group will be in person and we will also provide a Zoom connection for people who are unable to attend the group in person.

October Mission Emphasis

The October Missions Blue Envelope Emphasis is designated for UMCOR. As the humanitarian relief and development arm of The United Methodist Church, the United Methodist Committee on Relief -UMCOR – assists United Methodists and churches to become involved globally in direct ministry to persons in need. UMCOR comes alongside those who suffer from natural or humancaused disasters – famine, hurricane, war, flood, fire or other events—to alleviate suffering and serve as a source of help and hope for the vulnerable. UMCOR provides relief, response and long-term recovery grants when events overwhelm a community's ability to recover on their own.


Thank You Family Promise Volunteers
