June 2024 Missions Emphasis (Family Promise)



The Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN) is Family Promise Montco PA's emergency shelter program. The Network provides Montgomery County families with children who are experiencing homelessness with a safe place to stay, along with supportive services, for approximately 90 days. Family Promise Montco PA participates in Your Way Home, Montgomery County's unified and coordinated housing crisis response system for families

and individuals experiencing or at imminent risk of homelessness.

Twenty-six "host" and "buddy" congregations house and support our families for one month each year at their places of worship. Families are provided with comfortable accommodation in classrooms converted to bedrooms or other safe spaces. Volunteers from the congregation, who typically contribute more than 3,000 hours of their time each year, prepare and share meals, provide overnight assistance, and help with transportation. Many volunteers make special connections to our families, often providing a level of genuine intrinsic support that bolsters our families and brings them further into a community that is invested in their success.

Participating families spend the day at work, school, or at Family Promise's Day Center, where staff provides intensive case management and comprehensive support services to help families resolve their homelessness. These services help parents care for themselves and their families, improve their life skills and decision-making abilities, and develop the internal resources necessary to become self-sufficient.

<u>Hope Gardens</u> is a housing program for low-income families with children. This program provides a secure home for families for up to two years while

they gain the tools, they need to become financially stable and selfsufficient. Families living at Hope Gardens receive comprehensive support services to help ensure their long-term success, including intensive case management, life



skills education, basic needs support, and aftercare to help ensure their long-term success and their continued stability after graduation from the program.

To address the disconnect between the needs of low-income families and the availability of affordable housing in Montgomery County Family Promise created a Supportive Housing Program at an Ambler property, Hope Forest, which opened in 2016, and a Lansdale property, Hope on Fifth, which was purchased in 2021. Both locations contain two apartments that can house two families moving toward self-sufficiency.

In addition to participating in the Interfaith Hospitality Network LUMC provides financial support for these and other programs provided by Family Promise.


Visit to St. John UMC in Bridgeton NJ on June 30
