

Lansdale UMC is following that promise in the form of a rainbow every day and we are committed to helping you along yours!


How can we be a source of encouragement to each other this month as we each navigate our own rainbow paths? Let's look for instances where we can show God's grace and mercy to one another.





UMCOR SUNDAY




