Your church family here at Lansdale UMC loves you! I cannot wait to see what God has planned for us this month!




Here's the challenge: This year we want to add 26 people across our Sunday School classes, Sunday morning attendees, Bible Studies, and other groups and committees.


Wherever you serve here at LUMC, think about how you can initiate impact! Who else could benefit from your program? Who could you invite to get plugged in to the happenings of LUMC?





WESLEYAN CLASS - LUMC LIBRARY


UPPER ROOM - ROOM A207 (UPSTAIRS)
