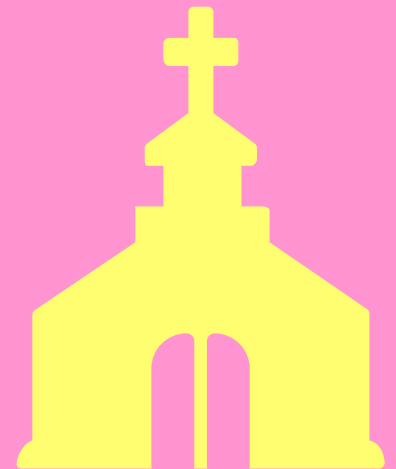

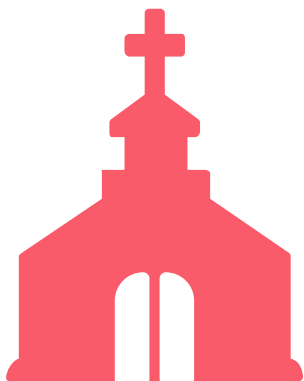

But God does not go on vacation! He is still here, working among us and in us! As folks travel here and there, let's remember to welcome all faces - both new and familiar.

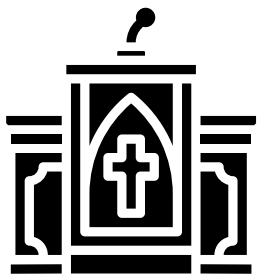

Thank you Karima!



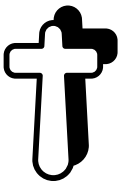

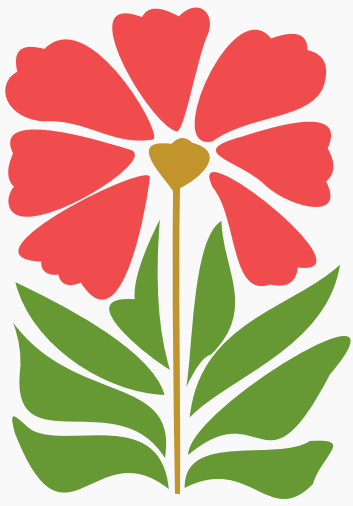

MOTHER TERESA MISSIONARIES FOR CHARITY

This month's mission emphasis comes from Shweta David, a fellow member of LUMC!

This past December of 2025, I went home to India with Sabah. My hometown is Baroda, which is in the state of Gujarat. When I was young, I attended the Centenary United Methodist Church in Fatehgunj, Baroda, India.

I also wanted my daughter to realize all the blessings she has in her life, and to see how other children with less means grow up in India.

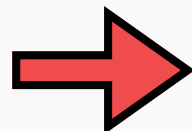
While in India, Sabah and I visited Mother Teresa Missionaries of Charity, which is based in Makarpura, Baroda, Gujarat. We met Sister Emmaculate there, who took us around the facility. We met women residents there who have some psychiatric conditions. These women were abandoned by their families on the roads, and picked up by the police who took them to Mother Theresa. Sister Emmaculate told us that these women were previously picked up by the sisters themselves, but since the Hindu Nationalist Government has been ruling in India, they cannot pick up women from the streets and bring them into the facility because of allegations of conversion.

We first cut cake with the women. They each got a piece of cake and were so happy and grateful. It just broke my heart, and I was in tears. I am a nurse and have seen my own patients die on my unit, but this was an entirely different level of pain and sorrow I felt.

I was so moved, that I kept on asking Sister Emmaculate what I can do for them. She said they do get food and clothes, but the facility needs a lot of work. The women's toilets were limited, probably around 6 or so for 100 residents, and they were broken and dirty. Sister Emmaculate told me that they did get funds previously from the government, but the Hindu Nationalist Government has stopped funding them.

Next, we went to the facility where the physically challenged children lived. They were all wheelchair bound, probably 8 of 10 kids at that time who again, were abandoned on the streets by their parents for their mental and physical disabilities. We cut cake there as well with them. Next, Sister Emmaculate took us to the facility where the sisters lived, and showed me what needed to be done on the veranda where they washed clothes and vessels. She said that they have knee deep water during monsoon seasons and it is a challenge. I felt that in order to serve the kids and the women better, the sisters needed to be taken care of.

The next day, a friend who is a contractor visited the facility with me, and Sister Emmaculate showed him the work that needed to be done. He started the work even before my relatives and myself could send him any funds. He completed the work in a month's time, and Sister Emmaculate and the other sisters were very happy with the work. After the work was completed, Sister Emmaculate reached out to me to let me know that they needed more work done. She said her priority is to get the toilets done where the women live.

I am hoping and praying that we can help the sisters at Mother Teresa who relentlessly take care of the women and children day and night and who have given their lives to serve people.

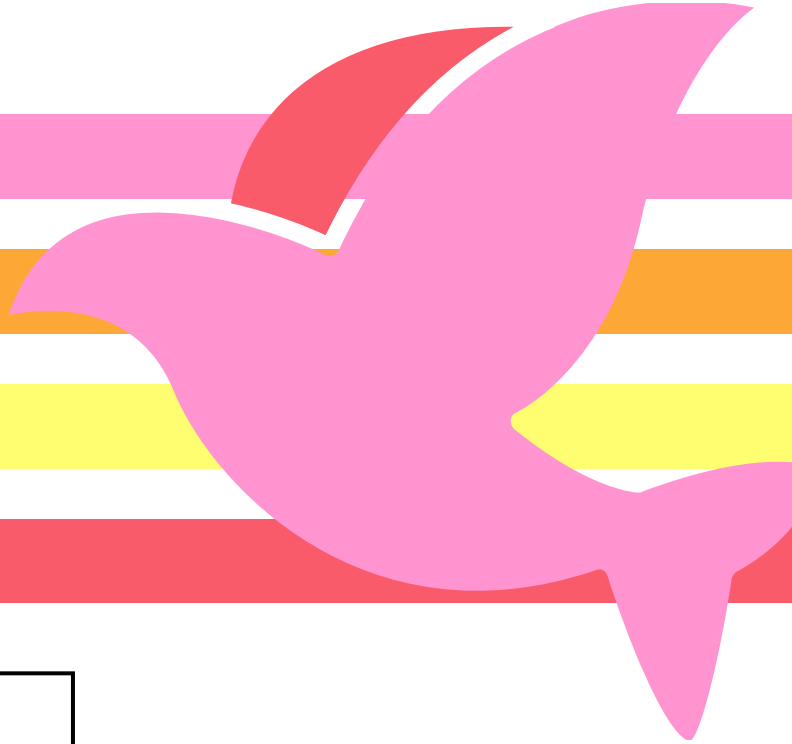
