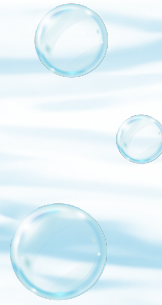

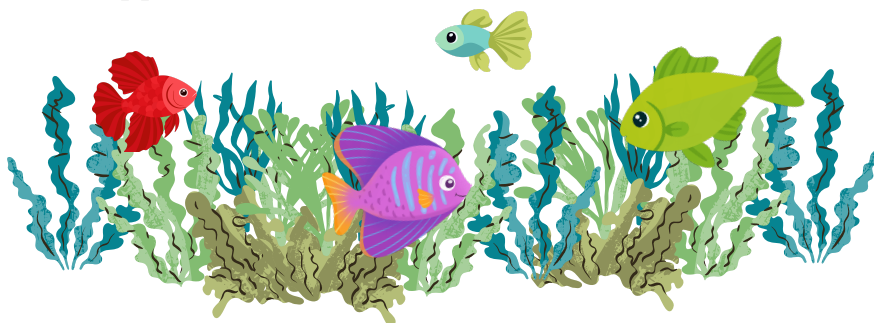

Welcome to July!

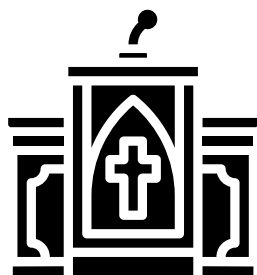

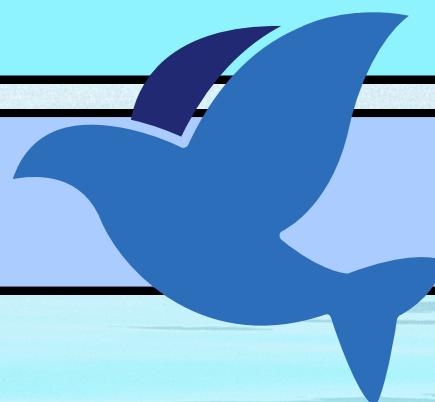

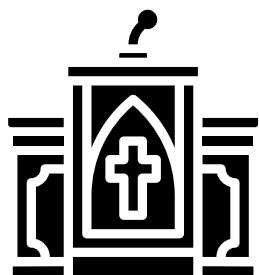

FROM THE PULPIT

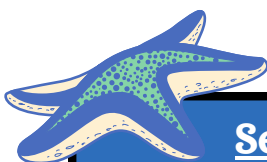

LAUREL HOUSE

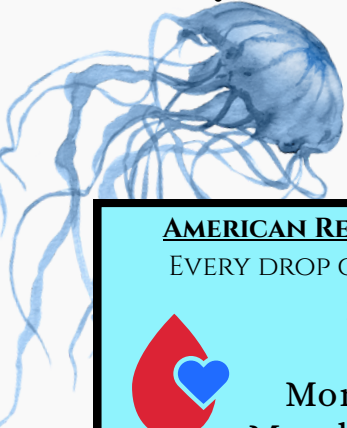
Laurel House is a comprehensive domestic violence agency serving individuals, families, and communities throughout Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. Laurel House is dedicated to the vision of ending domestic violence in each life, home, and community.

The Mission of Laurel House is to advocate for and empower those impacted by domestic violence by providing crisis intervention, safe haven, supportive programs, and resources, and to advance social change through preventative education, community training, and collaboration to foster a coordinated response to domestic abuse.

In addition to emergency shelter, Laurel House offers: a 24-hour hotline, a textline, transitional housing, a children's program, individual and group counseling, medical advocacy, legal representation and advocacy, crisis response, law enforcement collaboration, as well as community education and prevention efforts.

Laurel House purchased a building in Lansdale, PA, so that it can relocate its current shelter and expand support services. This new building is known as the Safe Haven Center. After more than ten years of planning and two years of renovation on a \$3.5 million building project, Laurel House's Capital Campaign, Rebuilding Lives, Restoring Hope, is complete! This building provides emergency shelter and support services to victims of domestic abuse and their families.

The Safe Haven Center increases the capacity and accessibility and provides much-needed enhancements in design, security, and amenities. This new, secure, and easily accessible facility houses an emergency shelter, which is the only one in the county, as well as some supportive services for domestic violence victims and their children. Thank you for continuing to support the important services that Laurel House performs for our community.
